HUDSON RIVER HERITAGE

Hudson River Heritage (HRH) is a not-for-profit membership organization dedicated to preserving the unique character of the Mid-Hudson Valley's historic architecture, rural landscapes, and scenic views through education, advocacy, and community involvement.

HRH is the federally designated steward of the Hudson River National Historic Landmark District, a 32-square-mile area reaching from Clermont in Columbia County to Hyde Park in Dutchess County. Federal landmark status recognizes that the historic resources in the heart of the Hudson Valley are of the highest national significance.

HRH keeps members informed about such preservation issues as the protection of Moul House in Red Hook and Goat Island in Tivoli Bays. The latter has been named by the Preservation League of New York State as one of the state's Seven to Save endangered properties for 2009.

HRH is set to respond to the Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement for Sailors Cove, a 380-unit Kingston waterfront complex that is visible from the Hudson River National Historical Landmark District.
